You will need 3 components to build a production vxVistA system.

	vxVistA Open Source Stack Which is comprised of all the M programs and other executables that make up the application code set. vxVistA 15.0 is licensed under the Apache 2.0 License.
	The M language data base engine If needed you can Request your 30 days / 30 users InterSystems Cache Evaluation License sending an email to eval@dssinc.com with your request including fullname and valid email address. It should be noted that in order to start all the VistA processes responsible to connect GUI apps to the database end, you would need more than a single user license
	Common Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes Primarily for US users, you will need the Common Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes from the American Medical Association. Since both Cache and the CPT codes are proprietary, they are not available from this open source website.

There are two versions, one for Windows Environment and one for Linux Environment
